

# **Behind Closed Doors**

# A playwright development series by 25th Street Theatre

# **Program description:**

What happens in those private spaces? The spaces that aren't for public consumption? What conversations are happening around us unseen? Would we understand people in a different way if we got to peek *behind closed doors*?

25th Street Theatre will gather a suite of six local playwrights to write a series of short plays around the theme of what happens behind closed doors. The selected playwrights will work with dramaturges over six months to develop scripts that can be performed as site-specific theatre, with the hope that we will create a memorable theatre adventure for patrons in the fall of 2025.

#### **Submission Information:**

Submission Deadline: November 15th, 2024 For your submission please include the following:

- Your resume
- A sample of your previous writing (max four pages)
- Your show pitches (max 500 words each). See below for details.

## **Pitch Requirements:**

For this project we are asking all interested playwrights to **pitch us two different scripts** based on the theme *Behind Closed Doors*. The pitches must be the following:

- First pitch: anything you would like it to be related to the theme of the project; and
- Second pitch: must be around the theme of "teaching rich, white men that not everyone has the same start" as requested by our main funder of this project.

A reminder that this will be site-specific theatre, so be sure to include information about where you envision your piece taking place.
