Description:

After a successful first iteration we are so excited to bring *Luna* back to life for another run this spring. *Luna* is once again coming to a school near you this spring as part of our Collaboration Station+: In Schools program!

12 year old Luna, has built a time machine in her Dad's garage, with the intention of unfreezing her mother - who is trapped in time. As she travels through time visiting dinosaurs, robots and childhood memories, she discovers that chasing the past is far more painful than facing the truth.

Luna is a play about grief, loss, depression and the strength it takes to move forward.

Character Descriptions:

- LUNA (Age 12) Female Identifying. Aspiring Scientist
- LUNA (Age 4, Age 11, and Grown Up) Female Identifying. Aspiring Scientist. (Note one actor will play Luna across all the listed ages)
- **FATHER/DAD** (30's 40's) Male Identifying. Widower. The Stay-At-Home Dad. Very in touch with his emotions.(Same actor as Scraps.)
- **SCRAPS** An excitable space robot that analyzes and studies the moon. Scraps was built by mother. (Same actor as Father.)
- **MOTHER/MOM** (30's 40's) Female Identifying. Award Winning Scientist. The BreadWinner of the family. Rarely home.

Only those selected for an audition, will be invited to submit a video. The first round of auditions will be video submissions with in person callbacks to follow if needed.

This production will be taking place as part of 25th Street Theatre's Collaboration Station+: In Schools program. As such, performers will be required to lead workshops with students at the various schools visited.
