WHAT'S THE FRINGE?

Operating for over 30 years, the Saskatoon Fringe Festival produced by 25th Street Theatre is an explosive celebration of art, community, and most importantly - THEATRE.

Now a global phenomenon, the first Fringe Festival began as an act of theatre rebellion in 1947 when a daring group of artists crashed the Edinburgh International Festival. Performing on the "fringe" of the event, they ignited a revolution of artistic exploration that lives on in every Fringer.

Today, over 250 Fringes are celebrated across the globe, pushing theatre boundaries and toasting to the artists who colour outside of the lines.

In Canada, "Fringe" is a trademarked brand. Every Canadian Fringe Festival is a member of the Canadian Association of Fringe Festivals (CAFF) and honours a set of shared ideals to work towards safe creative spaces that uplift artists. As a member of CAFF, shows in our main Fringe venues are selected via the Fringe lottery, allowing everyone the opportunity to have an audience.

For artists, Fringe is one of the most affordable ways to get their shows to the stage and to you, the audience.

1. GET TO KNOW THE PROGRAM

This Festival program is your guide to the Fringe. Whether it's onstage or on the street, explore every page for the ultimate Fringe experience.

2. GET CURIOUS

3. GET TALKING

Nothing sells a Fringe show like word of mouth. Connect with other Fringers, ask about the best performances, and if you liked something... say it!

Some of these artists have come a long way, and if you want those acts to get bigger and better every year, then we encourage you to get those tickets, tip your buskers, and spread the love.
